Sacramental Preparation

Requirements for First Reconciliation/First Communion

The CANDIDATE (Your Child)

1. Must have had at least a year of formal religious education (i.e. CCE classes, Catholic School, or approved homeschooling) prior to this year.
2. Must be baptized before celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Eucharist.
3. Must be 7 years of age or older before September 1 of the current year.
4. Must be at least in the second school grade.
5. Must have very good attendance in the Sacramental sessions. Absences will only be excused when accompanied by a valid reason.
6. Must know the required prayers. You will receive a copy of these at the parent meeting.

COMMUNICATION - always very important

Communication with the Director is the best way to resolve concerns. Please contact me with any questions related to the Reconciliation/ Eucharist preparation program.

PARENTS nurture the gift of faith of the child through

1. Personal witness in their own Christian lifestyle
2. Sharing their own faith experiences.
3. Prayer
4. Attending all scheduled sacramental sessions.
5. Assisting your child in learning required materials.
6. Attending Mass regularly with your child.
